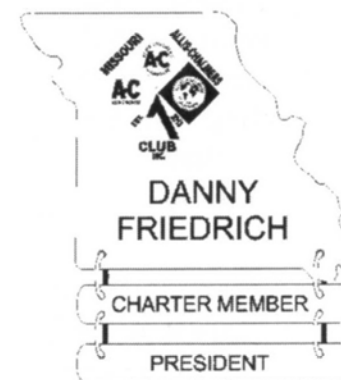

## NON MOAC CLUB SHOW VISITS & REPORT BY DALE BAUER

**October 1<sup>st</sup>:** Rick Maldeney, Kevin Bauer, and I visited a swap meet given by the ILL-MO Engine and Tractor club in Jerseyville, IL at the Fulkerson Mansion & Farm Museum. This was on the grounds of an old steam engine museum and there was only a small number of swappers there.

**October 21<sup>st</sup>:** Rick Maldeney, Kevin Bauer, and I visited a second show given by the ILL-MO Engine and Tractor club in Cedar Hill, MO. This is a small 1-day show held on a grassy area next to a grocery store. There were about 30 engines, including one from a furniture maker that had a band saw and patented wooden drum sander, all belt-driven by a large single cylinder engine. There were 7-8 lawn mowers and 7-8 tractors, several green ones, one Ferguson and 2 IH. No AC equipment showing. The show manager said that a guy who normally shows 3-4 AC tractors was having a few health problems and did not come.



**Upcoming – April 28, 2018** The same ILL-MO Engine and Tractor club is hosting a Spring Invitational Crank-Up on April 28, 2018 at the Daniel Boone Home near Defiance, MO.

A spring crank up show for us and other area tractor and engine clubs has been discussed for the past two years by ILL-MO Engine and Tractor and they think the Boone Home is one of the best show grounds they have seen.

Besides the Boone Home, there are over a dozen 19<sup>th</sup> century buildings that were moved there and all will be open during the show.

For the first year, this will be a one-day show. The ILL-MO Club will extend invitations to all of the tractor and engine clubs in the surrounding Missouri and Illinois area to participate.
